

The Wild Center's Library *Discovery Pass* Program 2022

Background: From the beginning, the primary goal of our library pass program is improved accessibility to The Wild Center for lower income families. Our ability to achieve that goal seems to be based on:

- Having the Discovery Pass in as many libraries as possible.
- Making families aware that the pass is available at their library.
- Keeping the pass affordable for the library, and for the user.

After a trial run of a few years, in 2016 The Wild Center opened up the Discovery Pass library card program to any library that wants to participate. In 2018, after talking with staff at different libraries, and reviewing the cost of the program, we added a modest co-pay of \$10 for the adults using the card, while the children age 17 and under continue to be admitted at no charge.

Main details about the Discovery Pass Program

- Any library may purchase our Library Discovery Passes at \$90 each. The pass program is good for 12 months.
- With the Discovery Pass, admission is free for four youth, ages 5 through 17. Young children (age 4 and under) are always free, so are not counted as part of the four free youth admissions.
- The Discovery Pass provides a discounted adult admission price of \$10 per adult - for up to two adults. The Wild Center's summer adult admission fee is \$20 per adult – and may go up - so the pass provides at least a half-price discount for the adults using the Discovery Pass.
- The summer full ticket price for a family of 4 is \$64, compared to the \$20 cost for a family of 4 using the Discovery Pass.

There is a “no co-pay” version of the card available for \$350 per year, with additional cards at \$175 each. This option allows for two adults and four youth, ages 5 through 17, to be admitted free.

Other Procedures and Policies:

Each Discovery Pass card will be printed with:

- name and address of the library
- 2 adults admitted, each with a \$10 co-pay (unless it is the no-copay card)
- at least 4 children thru age 17 will be admitted for free
- the Wild Center bar-code for referencing the library at Admissions
- the card's expiration date
- address, phone number and web address for The Wild Center
- a summary of the Wild Center's hours and schedule during the year, as our schedule changes seasonally.



Users of the Discovery Pass are not members of The Wild Center, so are not entitled to member discounts in the Museum Store or the Waterside Café.

We hope that libraries will help us achieve our goal of reaching low income families, by continuing to promote and offer the Discovery Pass to lower-income families as much as possible.
